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### Cripto-1 promotes epithelial-mesenchymal transition in prostate cancer via Wnt/ $\beta$ -catenin signaling

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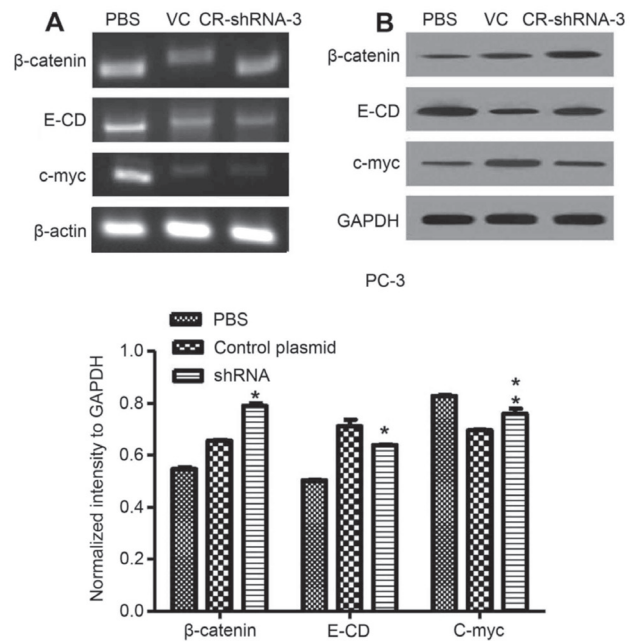


Figure 5. Silencing of CR-1 reverses the EMT phenotype in PC-3 cells. (A) CR-1 silencing of PC-3 cells were EMT-related at mRNA levels. ( $\beta$ -actin, internal reference). (B) CR-1 silencing PC-3 cells were EMT-related proteins. (GAPDH, internal reference) (\* $P < 0.01$  and \*\* $P < 0.05$ ).
